As we prepare for the weekend, we would like to update the community of the continued closure of our recreational facilities. Although this may seem overly cautious to some, guidelines prepared by the government of Alberta outline regulations for beach, recreation, and playground operators that must be met and upheld for us to safely reopen. We have a working plan in place to satisfy the guidelines, but because of the limited inventory of necessary supplies available for purchase, we have not been prepared to open. We will continue to monitor the situation, and will update you as things change.

Take precaution in outdoor spaces:

- Plan your activity in advance to ensure physical distancing of at least 2 metres is possible:
 - consider going during non-peak hours walk along the sides of trails and other public pathways to maintain distance
 - wear a mask to help limit the risk of spread to others
- Practise good hand hygiene:
 - wash your hands frequently
 - refrain from touching your face with unclean hands
 - carry and use hand sanitizer
